KOSTIANTYN VOBLIY'S SCIENTIFIC SCHOOL: THE 140-TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE BIRTH OF SCIENTIST

Summary

The article deals with life and formation stages of a famous scientist and economist Konstantin G. Voblyi (1876–1947) as a scientist, with his scientific legacy.
