**BETWEEN WORD AND DEED. THE AGRICULTURAL MARKET OF  
UKRAINE IN TERMS OF THE SCIENTIFIC IDEAS AND BUSINESS  
PRACTICES (1990 - 2000'S)**

**Summary**

On the basis of source materials, works of local researchers analyzed the complex processes of territorial organization of independent Ukraine agriculture that fueled radical change in the paradigm of social and economic changes caused by the need to overcome the consequences of post-communism and the establishment of European civilization practices. It is concluded that the formation in Ukraine a market economy was agrarian in distinctly different from international practice conditions, as lacking the experience of Gosplan transition to market regulators. Domestic scientists found that South - Eastern Europe, who performed similar steps have succeeded primarily because both quickly completed a set of tasks, have implemented private ownership of the means of production; developing competitive environment, which was based on the ratio of demand, supply and free economic initiative; using labor as a commodity; introduced state regulation where the market does not provide the desired results public, that comply zakoniv.Na objective economic analysis based on numerous politico - legal, socio - economic factors examined processes related to the

approval of Ukraine in the global food market, in particular in the segments as adaptation to international quality standards of agricultural products, attracting foreign investment, joint ventures, achieving competitiveness. For the first time in the national historiography attempts to clarify the role and place of the Ukrainian village in the processes of state-building, integration of independent Ukraine in international and European institutions.
